Romantic Gifts for Him...

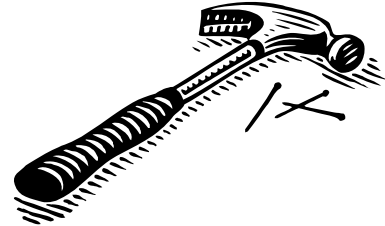
